Dear Parents:

As our nine week report card period ends, I would like to inform you of some Marshall High School grading rules for turning in assigned daily work and for failures on major grades. All of these rules apply to our general classes and not our dual college credit or AP classes.

Students on occasion forget to turn in daily assignments that are due and Marshall High School has a rule that you will have five school days to get that late assignment turned in before it turns into a zero. After the five days, the zero will stay in the gradebook. Teachers provide before and after school tutorials to assist your child in making up the assignment within the five days. The highest grade for work redone will be a 70. Students who fail the semester will be required to attend summer school or repeat the course next year. All students must pass all required courses to graduate from Marshall High School. It is important that your child stay focused, listen to instruction, and complete assignments on time to get credit for the course. Failure of a nine weeks also results in nonparticipation of all UIL activities. You as a parent may go onto to Skyward and view your child's grades. It is our goal to have 100% graduating MHS each year. However, failure to pass a class and complete assignments will result in failing of a course and losing credit for graduation.

Also, parents, it is a district policy requires students in general classes to retake major grades in which a student received below a 70. They must inform the teacher that they want to retake the test or be allowed to redo a major grade. The highest grade they can receive is a 75. Please make sure your child is telling the teacher that they need to make up the major grade. If a major grade has not been taken care of by the end of the progress reporting period, they will not be allowed to go back and make up that grade. If a major grade is not made up before the end of the nine weeks, the student will not be allowed to go back and make up that grade. Again, this does not include AP or dual credit classes. Please remember you can go on Skyward to see what major grades they have and make sure they get a make-up opportunity.
